Acquire the skills and competencies that will position you to be a knowledgeable member of a healthcare team. Gain required information that will enable you to move forward in health careers in a number of different settings. Engagement in the certificate program provides essential hands on opportunities critical for assuming roles in the healthcare industry. The certificate is a pathway, which articulates to degrees in Public Health and Health Sciences.

The health care curriculum prepares students to function as entry-level workers on a health care team. The curriculum will also allow the student to earn the Certified Nurses Aid Credential from the appropriate agency.

Students completing this curriculum with a cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher will receive a certificate in health care. This certificate can be added to any associate or bachelor's degree seeking student's program of study. The certificate can also be earned as a stand-alone credential. Stand alone certificate programs are not eligible for financial aid. Students completing certificate programs while also pursuing an associate or bachelor's degree may be eligible for financial aid. Students should check with the Office of Financial Aid to determine eligibility.
